You have arrived at the Batson River. The estuary this river feeds is part of the Rachel Carson Wildlife Refuge. This dam and mill pond was used as a major source of ice for Kennebunkport through the 1930's. Ice was cut from the river, beginning not long after Thanksgiving, and hauled to an ice house on site by horses. Sawdust was used as insulation. Questions: How many cubic feet of ice are equal to one ton? _____ Find the old cylindrical metal object near the fence. What was the metal drum used for? _____</i>	<p>2 answers:</p> <p>a short ton = 2000lbs, a long ton (gross) = 2240 lbs. There is 62 lbs in 1 cu. ft. of ice. We will accept as correct answers 32.25 - 36.13 The cylindrical object was used as a snow roller.</p>
